

**Licking Elementary**  
**Behavior Bootcamp**  
**Lesson Plan**

**Bus**

**Materials Needed:** Bus

**Time:** 15-20 minutes

**Expectations:** Show respectful, responsible, behaviors while riding on a bus.

**Objective:** Students will be able to understand that it is a privilege to ride the bus and safety is imperative in the process of getting them to and from school without injury.

**Discuss and Model Positive Examples:**

- Obey the driver, use appropriate language, keep hands and feet to ourselves, Use level 2 voices (normal talking)
- Face Forward, bottom in seat-No seat belts but the seats will not be safe unless everyone's bottom is in the seat where it belongs.
- Safe loading and unloading procedures
- No items, hands, arms, heads, etc. outside of the bus windows
- No food, drink, gum, etc.
- Stay out of the aisle so the driver can clearly see out of the back glass, free of obstructions.

**Discuss and Model Negative Examples:**

- Turned around in seat, yelling, hanging out in the aisle, hanging out the window, sitting on feet in seat, not listening to the driver

**Practice the above lesson correctly with students.**
