Virtual Student and Parent Responsibilities

- Families borrowing school-issued Chromebooks and/or assistance with connectivity through hot spots on loan from the district assume full responsibility of devices. The hotspots will carry the district's content filter and will be locked to the student's device. In addition, students will be issued textbooks that will be used to support instruction.
- Students will be expected to log in to daily live virtual lessons that will be conducted between 8:00 AM and 3:15 PM. Students are expected to participate in all scheduled lessons. When not participating in live virtual lessons, students will have independent work to complete. The workload will be similar to the workload of students who are in traditional seated classes. Attendance will be taken daily. Students must be signed into their virtual classroom at the beginning of class time. Students who are late will still be responsible for content missed due to being late. A schedule of class hours are included with this letter.
- Students who do not meet attendance and/or work completion expectations will be transitioned from virtual learning back into the traditional seated classroom at the end of the quarter.
- Students who elect to enroll in virtual learning **are not eligible** to participate in school athletics, activities, clubs or field trips.
- Meal service will **not** be provided to virtual students.
- Virtual students are held to the same policies and expectations as students attending seated classes. Licking R-VIII Board Policies apply to virtual students.
- When visiting campus, virtual students must check into the high school office prior to going anywhere on campus.
- Students are expected to adhere to computer etiquette while participating in virtual classes. Students shall be dressed appropriately, seated at a table or desk, and be aware of their surroundings during streaming of classes.
- Teachers are available through Microsoft Teams chat function as well as Remind (where necessary) for classroom assistance. Be sure to read teacher syllabi for further details specific to each class.
- Students must be visible through Microsoft Teams during class time in order to confirm attendance.
- No person or entity is permitted to record or re-broadcast classes without written consent from Licking School District.
